





## Pattern Language

## Logo Concept

The Fuego logo is built on instinct, heat, and heritage.

At the center is a crow—clever, wild, and fiercely independent. In Mexican symbolism, crows are not just tricksters or messengers—they're survivors. Ours wears a crown, not for show, but for dominance. It's earned, not given.

Behind it, the flame burns hot. Fire in Mexican culture is sacred—used in cooking, rituals, and resistance. It's how we mark beginnings, celebrate intensity, and bring flavor to life.


